The Bell Foundation's EAL Assessment Framework for Schools enables us to assess pupils' proficiency in English effectively, set clear targets for their development, and monitor progress over time. This framework helps us to identify specific areas where pupils may need additional language support, such as speaking, listening, reading, or writing.

Our strategies to support EAL pupils include:

- **Differentiated Teaching and Learning:** We adapt lesson plans and resources to ensure they are accessible to EAL pupils, incorporating visual aids, practical tasks, and hands-on learning where appropriate.
- **Small Group and 1:1 Interventions:** We provide targeted interventions to help pupils develop their English language skills in a supportive and focused environment.
- **Staff Training and Development:** Our team receives training on effective strategies for supporting EAL learners, including how to use Bell Foundation resources to inform practice.
