

COVID CODE OF CONDUCT

It is essential that we all work together to minimise the risk to the Elysian community.

Everyone has their part to play. Young people are expected to adhere to the following:



Specifics	
Arrival at School	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Please wash your hands by the Food Cabin on arrival at school.
Personal Space	<ul style="list-style-type: none">When speaking face-to-face, try and keep some distance between you and the other person(s).Try to avoid entering someone's personal space. Watch out for body language, as they may feel uncomfortable with the distance between you and them but feel embarrassed to say something. Ask them, "Is this okay?" if you are unsure.
Moving around	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Pay close attention to others as you move around the site. This is particularly important inside but also applies outside.
Wearing masks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Face masks are available if you would feel more comfortable – please ask at reception if you would like one.If you are arriving by a taxi or public transport, you may be asked to wear a mask and it is always best to have a fresh, clean mask for both the journey to and from Elysian.
During your learning day	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Please wait for permission from a member of staff before entering the office.Throughout the day please remember to wash your handsPlease do not move any furnitureWindows will be open to ensure ventilation.
Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Lunch is at 12.30 every day – please only eat inside one of the buildings with a member of staff present. Please wash your hands before entering.There are water fountains in the Food Cabin and the Cow Shed – please do not use your own bottles but use the cups provided.Please remember to clear everything away when you have finished lunch.

The measures described above fulfil or exceed Government guidance and should help everyone to feel safe and relaxed at Elysian.
